- 1. Top Priorities for legislation: Reevaluate this master plan and the past 4 years of zoning changes. Be considerate of community involvement.
- 2. Getting answers to specific issues: I would have monthly town hall meetings. The council person for the area affected should work directly with you. If they don't then come directly to the county executive.
- 3. Provide public with user friendly notifications of decisions by DAC and zoning: Anyone affected by the decision needs to be notified right away. Otherwise announcements at monthly town hall meetings and an open door policy also your representative should keep their district informed. Communication is number one.
- 4. Term limits for county council members. Yes definitely.
