Local & State Advocacy

Published the FoH Scorecard for various Harford County land use bills, to include FoH opinion and the voting record of the County Council.

Provided public testimony for Bill 23-005/23-025 Warehouse Moratorium, Bill 23-006 Natural Resource District, Bill 23-011/Bill 23-027 Apartments in B3, Bill 24-001 Accessory Dwelling Units (ADU), Bill 24-002 Agricultural Land Preservation.

Participated in the two-day Historical Society 250th Celebration event, providing insights into the mission and history of FoH, established in 1997.

Community Outreach & Education

Provided input on the development process for the Perryman Peninsula and Abingdon Woods, advocating for zoning updates related to warehouses.

Spoke with community groups and individuals about efforts on revising impact fees and Adequate Public Facilities- schools.

Issued **FoH Alerts** nearly every month to more than **700 FoH subscribers** for Public Input, Community Input Meetings (CIM), Development Advisory Committee (DAC) meetings, Special Exception (SE) hearings, and Board of Appeals Cases.
